## **BREAKING OUT STOCK BY HAND: THE SIX STEPS**

- Choose one face of your stock and plane it **flat** with the **jack plane**.
  - be sure to plane with the grain
- 2 Plane one edge 900 to the *first finished face*.
  - be sure to check the face and edge for **900** with the **try square**
- Plane the board to *thickness* with the <u>jack plane</u>.
  - be sure to mark the *thickness* all the way around the board on the *edges and ends* with the <u>marking gauge</u>
- 4 Rip the board to *width* with a <u>hand saw.</u>
  - be sure to cut on the **waste side of the line** and finish the edge with the **jack plane**
- Crosscut one end of the board square with the **back saw**.
- **6** Crosscut the final end of the board square with the **back saw**.
  - be sure to hold the saw properly to cut 90°
