USING THE POWER MITER SAW

- The power miter saw is used for **cross-cutting** wood to length.
- Measure and mark where you want to cut your board.
- Set the saw to the appropriate angle.
- Hold the board firmly against the fence.
- The saw kerf should be on the waste side of your line.
- Engage safety switch and power switch and cut through slowly and evenly.

If you want to cut more than once piece to the same length you can set a stop.

 Keep a hand on your wood while you lift the blade and let go of the switches to turn off the machine.
