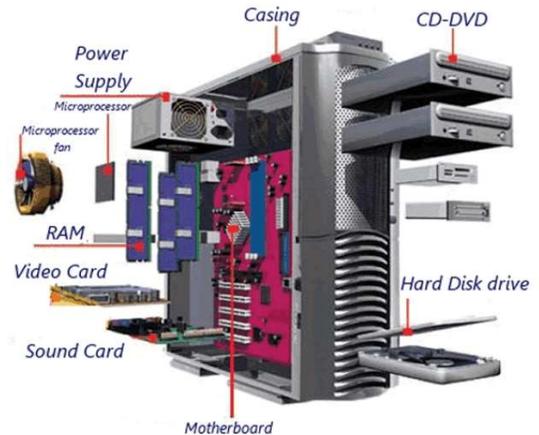

Computer Component Research and Presentation

Computers today have many separate components that have very specific purpose, operation, and interfacing. Learning about each component in detail will help you understand how a computer works, its operation, and more importantly how to troubleshoot if needed. Focus will be on 4 related sub-topics to have a better understanding of that component and later share with the rest of the class. Each student is to pick a unique computer component out of the list on the sign-up sheet.



With your selected computer component, you are required to research, create a rough report for feedback and then create a presentation to explain your component, its purpose, parts, operation, how it works, and how it works in the computer. Use a 50/50 text to picture ratio, 4-6 detailed points with large text size, and contrasting colours for easy reading. The following *Key content (information) is to be included in your presentation using the following order:

- Component Title Page (1) & General Description (2), Overview (1)
- Similar topics: Hardware Parts (2), Normal Operation (2), How it Actually Works (2), Variations (2)
- Summary (3)
- Resources you used (-5 if not included)

Use Google Slides to build your presentation and present with-in 3 to 4 min., by expanding on your points (not reading your slides) with your class. Further details and resources can be found on the course website.
