RIPPING A BOARD ON THE VARIETY SAW

- After cross-cutting a board to length and jointing one face and one edge square, the board can now be **ripped to width.**
- **2** Raise the **saw blade** so that the **teeth** are *just above the surface of the board.*
 - Be sure that the blade is square to the table.
- **3** Measure, adjust and lock the **rip fence** to the proper width.
 - Before ripping be sure blade guard is back in its proper place.
- **4** Turn machine on and begin to rip stock.
 - Be sure jointed edge is against fence to prevent jamming the board and possible kick-back
- **5** Use a **push-stick** to push stock all the way past the blade.
 - Always use the push-stick to remove stock that is close to the blade.
- **6** Turn machine **off** when finished.
