FILES, RASPS, and OTHER CARVING TOOLS

- In order to shape the curves of a wooden project, excess wood can be removed with rasps and files.
- 2 Rasps and files are made of *hardened steel* with teeth cut into their surfaces.
 - **You must never** hit a rasp or a file on a hard surface because it will break.
- Rasps and files are available in many shapes, sizes, tooth sizes and tooth arrangements to suit many different carving situations.
- Rasps and files can be cleaned with a **file card** or **mineral spirits**.
- Rasps and files cannot be sharpened and must be properly stored to prevent dulling the teeth.
- Other carving tools include: Carving chisels
 - also available in many shapes and sizes
