USING THE LATHE

- The main parts of the lathe are the head and tail stock, the bed, and the tool rest.
- 2. Items such as table legs, bowls, tool handles, and baseball bats can be turned on the lathe.
- 3. Stock must have the centres marked on each end for mounting between the head and tail stocks.
- Wide and shallow pieces can be produced by turning on the face plate. Stock must be screwed securely to the faceplate before starting.
- 5. Cutting tools must be held with both hands in order to maintain control and safe operation. Some larger lathes have a clamp built into the tool rest.
- 6. Sanding may be done while the work is still mounted on the lathe. Great care must be taken while sanding to prevent injury.
