BREAKING OUT STOCK BY MACHINE: THE SIX STEPS

- Choose a *concave* face of your stock and joint it **flat** on the **jointer**.
 - be sure to joint with the grain
- 2 Joint *one edge* 90° to the first finished face.
 - be sure to hold finished face firmly *against the fence* to get a 90° corner
- Plane the board to *thickness* in the <u>thickness planer</u>
 - be sure to have the rough side up
- 4 Rip the board to *width* on the <u>table saw.</u>
 - be sure to put the jointed edge against the rip fence
- **5** Crosscut **one end** of the board square on the **mitre saw**
- Crosscut the *final end* of the board square on the <u>mitre saw</u>
 - be sure the saw is **adjusted properly** to **cut 90**°
