

## BILL OF MATERIALS / CUTTING LIST

- ① In order to complete a woodworking project it is necessary to have a **bill of materials**
- ② The bill of materials lists all the **finished** parts of a woodworking project
- ③ For each of these parts the bill of materials includes the **number** parts, the **name** of each part, the **dimensions** of each part, the **type of wood** for each part and the **cost**.
- ④ A **rough stock list** or **cutting list** is made from a bill of materials
- ⑤ The cutting list is similar to the bill of materials in form and headings but the dimensions of each piece of stock is **slightly larger** to account for cutting and planing the wood to finished size.
- ⑥ If a finished part of a project is made from several same sized pieces of wood, the rough size listed is for **one** of those pieces.
- ⑦ The following is a typical bill of materials / cutting list table
