THE DISK SANDER

- The prime function of the **disk sander** is to sand outside curves and end grain wood.
- 2 The size of a disk sander is determined by the *diameter of the disk*.
- The usual grit size of the sandpaper is from 40 to 80 and is attached to the disk with <u>heat resistant contact cement.</u>
- Before beginning any work on the disk sander, open the <u>blast gate</u> to the <u>dust</u> <u>collector.</u>
- The disk sander **must not** be used to remove large amounts of stock, use a cutting tool to remove most of the waste then finish off with the disk sander
- Place work against *downward turning face of disk* so that stock can be supported by the table.
 - Be sure to keep fingers well away from sanding disk and gap between disk and table to prevent serious injury.
- Turn machine off when finished
